- Quality Endorsement selection for Cohort 3 begins this summer and will be completed with self study by April 1st 2018. 14 Affiliates were selected and 8-9 will be participating.

Baby Net Update- Local Offices

- Work underway to integrate BabyNet and Medicaid eligibility and data processes
- Schedule for moves of local offices is pending
 - Preparation includes transfer of local operating contracts, data transfers, phones, etc.
 - Analysis of referrals for FFY 2016 and staffing patterns to begin mid-April




Early Head Start-Child Care Partnership Grant Award



- \$16.2 million over 4 ½ years
- 162 additional children
- 11 counties (expands capacity within 9 of 12 Round 1 counties and adds two underserved - Fairfield and McCormick)

Total EHS-CCP Funding: \$34.7 million, 14 counties, 416 slots

SC First Steps to School Readiness Early Head Start - Child Care Partnerships (EHS-CCP)



EHS-CCP: Round 1: ★ 254 slots **12** counties

EHS-CCP: Round 2: ★ 162 additional slots 11 counties (9 counties from Round 1 and 2 new additional counties)

Beginning March 1, 2017

EHS-CCP Round 2 Centers will be selected by end of May
