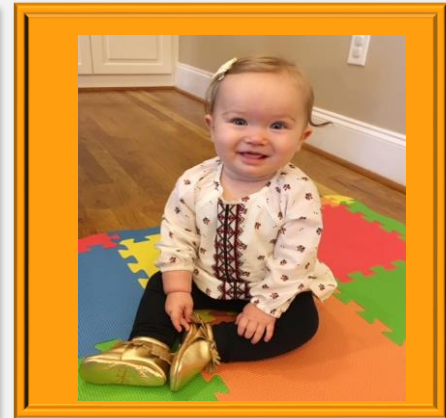

Early Head Start Update
