Preschool Development Grant Overview and Update

Joint Press release from Governor's Office and DSS sent out last week (local partnerships received copy via email)

The \$3.5 million grant will help South Carolina:

- Develop and update its strategic plan based on the assessment of all child services statewide.
- More efficiently use existing federal, state, local and nongovernmental resources to strengthen existing programs or create new ones.
- Encourage partnerships between entities that provide child services.
- Improve the transition between home/preschool to school.
- Centralize information about services.



What is the Pyramid Model?

- Public health, tiered model
- Promotion, prevention, intervention
- Promote the development of <u>all</u> children
- Provides a conceptual framework for a comprehensive array of interventions and approaches

The Pyramid Model:

Promoting Social and Emotional Competence and Addressing Challenging Behavior



The Goal of the Pyramid is to Promote Children's Success By:

Creating an environment where EVERY child feels good about coming to school.

Designing an environment that promotes child engagement.

Focusing on teaching children what TO DO!

- Teach expectations and routines.
- Teach skills that children can use in place of challenging behaviors.

SCFS Pyramid Implementation Plan

Recruit interested Local Partnerships to focus on developing their Training Plans to include intensive Pyramid training, coaching, and support (infants, toddlers, preschool)

Coordinate State-wide Master Pyramid Cadre partners (e.g., Head Start, Inclusion Collaborative, etc.) in recruited counties to support full implementation of Pyramid with child care center staff, families, and other stake holders Provide training, coaching, and support to participants

Coordinate Statewide TAPs training with CCCCD

Plan and Implement TAPs training (FS Program Officers with 4K Coordinator, and other Master Cadre partners)



2017-18 State PAT Data

- 47 Affiliates in SC (37 have some or all FS Funds)
- 73% of First Steps funded Affiliates met all 17 ER's.
- 56% of National Affiliates met all 17 ER's-
- National Goal for all is 75% now raised to 80%
