Background/History of HIPPY

- Developed in 1969 at Hebrew University in Israel for:
 - Families experiencing economic disadvantage
 - Limited proficiency in dominant language
 - Immigrant families
 - Brought to the US in 1984
 - HIPPY USA national office moved to Arkansas in 2007 in partnership with Arkansas Children's Hospital.
- Currently serving over 15,000 families living in 21 states and D.C.

30 Weeks

Structured Curriculum for Cognitive and Social Development



Home Visits

weekly and Group Meetings Monthly



Peer to Peer

Home visitors are peers from the community in which they serve
