Overarching Measure(s) of Success

BAMBERG COUNTY FIRST STEPS WILL INCREASE THE REACH OF FIRST STEPS SERVICES IN OUR COMMUNITY

By 2023, the percentage of children in need who are directly served by Bamberg County First Steps will increase from 15% to 20%

BAMBERG COUNTY FIRST STEPS WILL INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CHILDREN ENROLLED IN HIGH INTENSITY PROGRAMS FUNDED BY FIRST STEPS

By 2023, the percentage of children directly served by First Steps enrolled in high intensity programs will increase from 69% to 75%.

BAMBERG COUNTY FIRST STEPS WILL INCREASE THE AVAILABILITY OF HIGH-QUALITY EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES OFFERED BY FIRST STEPS

By 2023, the percentage of children under age 6 who benefit from First Steps quality enhancement and training efforts will increase from 83% to 90%.



Objectives

Bamberg County First Steps will increase the capacity of parents to be their child's first and most important teachers by expanding the Parents as Teachers evidence-based home visiting program.

1. Bamberg County First Steps, a National Blue Ribbon Parents as Teachers (PAT) Affiliate, will increase parental capacity by utilizing the Parents as Teachers (PAT) Curriculum, an evidence-based home visiting program designed to build strong communities, thriving families and children who are healthy, safe and ready to succeed.
2. The Parents as Teachers (PAT) Program will integrate services utilizing the Life Skills Progression and other Needs Assessments to refer and link families to additional interventions.
3. The Parents as Teachers (PAT) Program will integrate services with the DSS/ABC Childcare Scholarships Strategy for working families and those attending school fulltime.

Objectives

Bamberg County First Steps will improve and strengthen families by affording quality DSS/ABC Child Care Scholarships to working families and those attending school fulltime.

1. Bamberg County First Steps Childcare Scholarships are vouchers that affords working parents opportunities for quality daycare to promote the healthy development and school readiness of their children.

2. Bamberg County First Steps Childcare Scholarships Strategy will integrate quality services with the Parents As Teachers Evidenced-Based (PAT) Model.

3. Bamberg County First Steps Childcare Scholarships Strategy will collaborate with the Department of Social Services, our local school districts and local childcare providers to ensure quality services.

Objectives

Bamberg County First Steps will connect families of preschool children to services designed to strengthen families and promote optimal child development

- 1.** Bamberg County First Steps will serve as a local portal for connecting families of preschool children to community based services in order to ensure the school readiness of our youngest learners. The partnership will work diligently with local and regional coalitions and committees that focus on the mission of children and families.
- 2.** Bamberg County First Steps will increase access, build capacity and strengthen interagency accountability and community collaboration.
- 3.** Bamberg County First Steps will develop community educational and outreach activities to raise awareness and engage the local community about the importance of First Steps and our contributions to our local families and our youngest learners.

STRATEGY 1.1

Parents as Teachers

SMART GOAL(S)

1. Bamberg County First Steps will increase the numbers of families enrolled and served in the parenting program by 30%.
2. Bamberg County First Steps will ensure that 100% of families served have two or more risk factors.
3. Bamberg County First Steps will increase assessment outcomes by 20% for the KIPS/ACIRI assessment tools.
4. Bamberg County First Steps will ensure 100% bi-monthly home visitations and family group connections.

COMMUNITY COLLABORATOR(S)

- Bamberg County First Steps will partner with local school districts, local childcare providers, the Department of Social Services, and the Department of Health and Human Services in its recruitment efforts of families with children ages prenatal through age three.

STRATEGY 1.2

Childcare Scholarships

SMART GOAL(S)

1. Bamberg County First Steps will increase the number of childcare scholarships to working families by 20% each year.
2. Bamberg County First Steps will ensure 100% of families receiving childcare scholarships will be enrolled in the Parents As Teachers Program and receive high quality wrap around services..
3. Bamberg County First Steps will ensure that 100% of PAT enrolled children will participate in high quality daycare programs.

STRATEGY 2.1

DSS/ABC Childcare Scholarships

SMART GOAL(S)

1. Bamberg County First Steps will ensure that 100% of children enrolled will receive comprehensive wrap around parenting services.
2. Bamberg County First Steps will ensure that 90% of families enrolled in parenting will qualify for a Childcare Scholarship to enhance school readiness skills.

COMMUNITY COLLABORATOR(S)

- Bamberg County First Steps will partner with local school districts, local childcare providers, the Department of Social Services, and the Department of Health and Human Services in its recruitment efforts of families with children ages prenatal through age three.

STRATEGY 2.2

Professional Childcare Training and Development

SMART GOAL(S)

- Bamberg County First Steps will increase the number of teachers enrolled in Professional Childcare Training and Development coursework by 25% by 2023.
- Bamberg County First Steps will ensure that 100% of First Steps funded earlycare programs receive a minimum of fifteen professional development training hours each year.

COMMUNITY COLLABORATOR(S)

- Bamberg County First Steps will partner with South Carolina Endeavors, DSS and local childcare providers.

STRATEGY 3.1

Community Education

SMART GOAL(S)

- Bamberg County First Steps will serve as a local portal to support the needs of all preschool aged children. **Great goal! We need to add a timeline to make its SMART.**
- Bamberg County First Steps will host community engagements and collaborative driven events to increase awareness of our school readiness initiatives. - Bamberg County First Steps will increase community awareness by affording the following : Monthly Family Connections Meetings, PAT Advisory Committee Meetings, The Annual Back to School Supplies Bash, The “MOMMYCISE” Health and Wellness Initiative, and The Santa’s Little Helpers Toys, Food & Clothing Initiative. **Each year?**
