STRATEGY 2.1

Parents as Teachers

SMART GOAL(S)

- Parents as Teachers will provide books and learning activities to all families enrolled through 2023
- 100% of children enrolled in PAT will have an ASQ completed at a minimum of 2 times annually through FY23 (appropriate referrals made as necessary)

COMMUNITY COLLABORATOR:

Union County Library (Parent Educators will promote the learning kits available at the library)

STRATEGY 2.2

Countdown to Kindergarten

SMART GOAL(S)

1. 20 children will be served annually through the Countdown to Kindergarten program

COMMUNITY COLLABORATOR:

UCFS will partner with the Union County School District to identify children needing CTK services, and to recruit teachers to serve.

STRATEGY 3.1

Early Childhood Council

SMART GOAL:

Early Childhood Council will meet a minimum of 3 times annually through 2023 with the goal of increasing the number of kindergarteners demonstrating readiness to 50% by 2023

COMMUNITY COLLABORATOR:

Union County School District will partner with UCFS in the formation and continuation of the Early Childhood Council

STRATEGY 3.2

KIDSFEST

SMART GOAL:

KIDSFEST will be held annually each spring through 2023 to promote access to agencies providing support and resources to families of preschoolers

Union County Library and Dept. of Social Services will assist in the planning of KIDSFEST
